

1. License Grant and Restrictions

1.1 CASA Networks (CN) grants the buyer a non-exclusive license to use the software in the package according to the terms set forth below. The software is licensed, not sold. The software is owned by CN and its suppliers, and its structure, organization and code are the valuable trade secrets of CN and its suppliers. United States Copyright law and International Treaty provisions also protect the software. You may not copy the software, except as provided in this agreement. Any copies that you are permitted to make pursuant to this agreement must contain the same copyright and other proprietary notices that appear on or in the software. By using all or any portion of the software, you accept all the terms and conditions of this agreement, except where it violates local law. Clauses deemed to violate local law are void under this agreement, but all other clauses remain in effect.

1.2 License Agreement

VectorWorks WebExchange has been purchased for a single, specific server-operating system per serial number. It is licensed for installation on one server for each serial number.

The VectorWorks WebExchange Export Module is free software and can be copied and distributed freely. All other licence agreements as described here, are valid.

The Buyer May:

- (a) Install and operate this software on one computer at a time.
- (b) Make one backup copy of the software, provided that the backup copy is not installed or used, which is automatically subject to this agreement.
- (c) Modify unprotected VectorScript routines provided with this software.

The Buyer May Not:

- (a) Make this software available to any person or entity other than employees who must use this software as specified above.
- (b) Modify or merge the software with another program, except for personal use as described above.
- (c) Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or otherwise attempt to discover the source code of the software except to the extent you may be expressly permitted to decompile under applicable law, it is essential to do so in order to achieve operability of the software with another software program, and you have first requested CN to provide the information necessary to achieve such operability and CN has not made such information available. CN has the right to impose reasonable conditions and to request a reasonable fee before providing such information.
- (d) Sub-license, sell, lend, rent, or lease any portion of the software without permission. The buyer may, after approval by CN (or authorized VectorWorks distributor if not in the USA), permanently transfer all (but no portion thereof) of the software to another person or entity, who in turn is subject to this agreement.
- (e) Operate the software on more than one computer at a time.

2. Upgrades

All upgrades or sequential versions of the program obtained under upgrade agreements or offered at a later date in consideration of this purchase will be considered one program under this license agreement. Under no circumstances will the providing of upgrades be considered as permission for this program to reside on more than one computer at any time, nor may the buyer sub-license, sell, lend, rent, or lease any portion of former versions of the software. Again, the license and the buyer's right to use the software

terminate automatically if the buyer violates any part of this agreement. In the event of termination of buyer's right to use the software, all copies of the software must be destroyed or immediately returned to CN.

3. Notes

This software involves valuable proprietary rights of CN and others. There is no transfer to the buyer of any title to, or ownership of, this software; nor is there transfer of any patent, copyright, trade secret, trade name, trademark, or other proprietary rights related to the software. The buyer may not violate these rights and must take appropriate steps to protect CN's rights. CN may at any time replace, modify, alter, improve, enhance, or change the software. The license and the buyer's right to use the software terminate automatically if the buyer violates any part of this agreement. In the event of termination of buyer's right to use the software, all copies of the software must be destroyed or immediately returned to CN.

For support and improvement reasons, the buyer allows CN administration access to the server software via internet. CN may not use any confident data in any way from buyers server contents.

4. General

This license agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Switzerland. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement and supersedes any prior agreement between CN and the buyer. In case of differences between the license agreement in the manual and the license agreement in the software, the license agreement in the software applies. Any translation of this license agreement is done for local requirements and in the event of a dispute between the German and any non-German versions, the German version of this license agreement shall govern. This agreement can be changed by CN without further notification. In case of differences, the actual published version on casa-networks.com applies.

5. Student and Educational Sales

Student and Education copies are sold under certain restrictions set at the time of sale. The user agrees to abide by the restrictions set forth for these versions.
